A. BACKGROUND

The Company is a cloud computing service provider. The Company intends to apply for registration of the cloud computing service to the state catalogue of cloud computing services of the Czech Republic. One of the requirements that the Company must meet in its application for registration is to list its potential obligations to disclose or provide the Customer Data and Specific Operational Data contained in the cloud computing service to public authorities of the states outside the Member States of the European Economic Area.

The purpose of this legal assessment is to provide a clear and comprehensible written description of the obligations under the law of the below specified country in which the Company expects potential disclosure or provision of Customer Data or Specific Operational Data to public authorities. The written description must be of such quality that enables the Customer to assess the suitability of the foreign country's legal regulation regarding the potential disclosure or provision of Customer Data or Specific Operational Data.

B. TERMS DEFINITIONS

- The Customer = a public authority of the Czech Republic.
- Customer Data = all data provided by the user to the Company as a provider while using the cloud computing service.
- Specific Operational Data = such traffic data that contains information about an identified or identifiable user of the cloud computing service.
- **Public authority** = public authority charged with the prevention, investigation, detection or prosecution of criminal offences or the execution of criminal penalties, including the safeguarding against and the prevention of threats to public security, an intelligence service, or another public authority with a similar scope of activity or with a similar power.
